



## Emergency Assistance

### Qualifications for Assistance

The client's household must meet the following criteria to be assisted by CANHelp's Emergency Assistance Program:

- Reside in CANHelp's established service area – proof of residency required (Currently Hopkins County, TX)
- Provide Identification for all household members over age 18
- Prove financial need
- Provide documents that show income, expenses, and crisis
- Have a viable action plan, or be willing to form a plan to prevent additional crises
- Income must not exceed 200% of the current (2017) Federal Poverty Guidelines as provided by the Department of Health & Human Services or be a segment of the vulnerable population:
